SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting monthly report as published by the Department of activities for the month of December, 1988.

Prchs SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase orders issued for amounts in excess of \$1,000.00 during the month of December, 1988, as shown in the Appendix.

Joint Agrmt SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into a joint agreement with McEntire Air National Guard Base to pave Roads "A" and "B" on the base using state primary/urban funds, as shown in the Appendix.

Agrmt Sverdrup Corp SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into an agreement with Sverdrup Corporation for repairs to the John P. Grace Memorial Bridge and the Silas N. Pearman Bridge in Charleston County at a cost of \$794,500, as shown in the Appendix.

US 17 Cons SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to advertise, interview and negotiate for a consultant to provide design services for U. S. Route 17 in Beaufort and Colleton counties, as shown in the Appendix.

Agrmt Isle of Palms Con SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement for design services on the Isle of Palms Connector (steel alternate), at an estimated cost of \$400,000 and using federal aid bridge replacement and rehabilitation funds, as shown in the Appendix.

Sup Agrmt SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into a supplemental agreement with Ralph Whitehead and Associates for seismic analysis/design for the new bridge over Dawhoo River in Charleston County at an estimated cost of \$83,700 using federal aid bridge replacement (BRF) funds, as shown in the Appendix.

Sup Agrmt SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving supplemental agreement No. 4 with Howard Needles Tammen and Bergendoff to extend the construction management services on the I-526 Cooper River and Urban Section bridge projects in Berkeley and Charleston counties at a cost not to exceed \$1,679,595 for the Cooper Section and \$198,237 for the Urban Section, as shown in the Appendix.

The Department requests Commission approval to advertise for and select an archaeological consulting firm for the purpose of entering into an agreement to provide archaeological data recovery and test excavations for the I-85 Relocation in Spartanburg County. The Scope of Work will encompass activities involved in surface collecting, subsurface testing, detailed archaeological excavations, and photography according to HABS-HAER standards.

Funding for this project will be Federal Aid Interstate funds.
