WHEREAS, while some forms of dysautonomia are considered rare diseases, other forms impact millions of people in the United States and around the world; and

WHEREAS, increased awareness of dysautonomia can lead to earlier diagnosis and treatment as well as improved outcomes for those it affects.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim October 2016 as

DYSAUTONOMIA AWARENESS MONTH

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to help raise awareness of these conditions and recognize the patients, families, and caregivers they affect.
