Mr. Gilreath called the meeting to order and Mr. Alexander gave the invocation. Everyone stood and Pledged Allegiance to the Flag.

Mr. Gilreath explained why this special meeting was called: To authorize a resolution authorizing a Block Grant Application for the County of Anderson, on behalf of E.C. Industries INC. to the South Carolina Job-Economic Development Authority administered by the office of the Governor of South Carolina.

Mr. Lynch, who was more familiar with this Resolution explained in more detail to County Council stating that: Anderson County will not be liable for this loan, such liability is being expressed by the Company. He further stated, that it would create twenty (20) new jobs immediately, and allow the Company to maintain approximately forty (40) jobs and expand the tax base of Anderson County to benefit the citizens and residents of Anderson County. Mr. Lynch then motioned that County Council approve this Resolution #200, to authorize the Block Grant Application for the County of Anderson. Mr. Alexander seconded, Council voted unanimously to approve.

Mr. Wiles made a motion to amend the agenda, so that he may present a second Resolution, concerning the Fire Department. Motion was seconded by Mr. Lynch, Council voted unanimously.

Mr. Wiles then introduced a Resolution (<sup>205</sup>~~#201~~) requesting that the Anderson County Delegation repeal Statute 52 stat.792, 1961 section 1, so that the Anderson County Council may establish Anderson County Fire Commission pursuant to Home Rule to provide the adequate funding thereof. Mr. Wiles then motioned that the Resolution be adopted. Motion was seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously.

Mr. Lynch made a second motion concerning the County Fire Commission, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, with a unanimous vote by Council, to direct the County Attorney to write a letter to the Delegation requesting an explanation for the Delegation's removal of a Fire Commissioner, and appointment of another.

Mr. Gilreath made a motion that Council adjourn, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously.

Council adjourned at approximately 5:30 p.m.
