A [Catholic News Source](#) reports that, "After spending nine years on death-row for alleged blasphemy, a Pakistani Catholic woman is requesting asylum abroad for herself and her family, and so far has received a mixed response: Italy has said it's open, while the United Kingdom allegedly denied the request due to concerns about 'unrest among certain sections of the community.'
