Hi Chaney, Butch Bowers suggested I contact you directly about the StoryCorps opportunity this Thursday. This is an exciting event for the State and the Midlands. South Carolina ETV, EdVenture and the South Carolina State Museum are hosting StoryCorps which is an oral history project and interviews that will be collected in Columbia and can be stored in the Library of Congress with participant permission. It is possible the interviews will also be included on NPR broadcasts with select stories animated and shown on South Carolina ETV each week.

We would love for the Governor to consider greeting StoryCorps to the Midlands with Mayor Benjamin at noon and then record her session at 12:30 afterwards this Thursday in the StoryCorps airstream currently located on the Edventure terrace at 211 Gervais St.

Remarks can be brief, just a request for the public to record their personal histories and the importance of passing South Carolina stories down from one generation to the next.
