FEATURED SPEAKER REPRESENTATIVE ROBERT COLE SPRAGUE of the 83rd Ohio House District has helped balance an \$8B budget deficit, cut nearly \$5B in personal income taxes, and sponsored an amendment that eliminated the Ohio Death tax. Rep. Sprague is pro-life, and a co-sponsor on the heartbeat bill. He is a defender of Second Amendment rights, with an A- rating from the NRA. Prior to public service, Robert was in the private sector at Ernst & Young, advising foreign and domestic companies on a number of complex business matters. He graduated from Duke University with a BSE in mechanical engineering and from the University of North Carolina with his MBA. On June 13, Rep. Sprague’s House Bill 249, “The Good Samaritan Law”, was signed into law. It includes the provision of criminal immunity to a person who seeks medical assistance for an individual experiencing a drug overdose.
