4-span prestressed concrete stringer bridge that carries two lanes of traffic on westbound I-20 across Shaw Creek. The bridge has prestressed concrete bents with flat caps, a concrete deck, and I-shaped stringers. The bridge railing is stamped with a 1968 date. However, per SCDOT guidance, a construction date of circa 1965 was used for this bridge evaluation.
