The regular monthly meeting of the Department of Transportation Commission was held at the Headquarters Building in Columbia, South Carolina at 1:30 p.m. In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, the news media was advised in writing of the time, date and place of this meeting.

SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of February 14, 2006; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving an amendment to the 2005 STIP, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the sale of surplus right of way property, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the request of the Department to advertise, select and negotiate with firms to provide travel demand modeling services on an "on call" basis, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the request of the Department to select and negotiate with firms to provide surveying services on a statewide "on call" basis, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department related to roads in the State Highway Secondary System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department concerning projects in the highway lettings of February 14 and February 21, 2006, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: Commissioner Jones reported for the Invitations and Resolutions Committee and reported that the committee approved a process for "Big Check" ceremonies, as well as a process for naming roads and bridges.

Commissioner Jones made a motion that the Commission approve the processes along with the following resolutions:

- Interchange located at the intersection of US Highway 78 and US Highway 15 in the City of St. George named the "Nell Bennett Interchange"
- Interchange at the intersection of I-95 and SC Highway 9 in Dillon County named the "Judge Bill McLeod Interchange"
- Portion of Highway 76/378 in Sumter (known as the Broad Street Extension) from Loring Mill Road to SC Road 441 named "Ramon Schwartz, Jr. Highway"
- Interchange Located at the intersection of US Highway 1 and Clemson Road in Richland County named the "John David Monroe, Sr. Interchange"
- Bridge along Highway 17 that crosses SC Highway 22 in Horry County named the "Lewis A. Singleton Bridge"
- Future bridge that will cross the Combahee River along US Highway 17 in Colleton County named the "Harriet Tubman Bridge".
- Erect markers at Exit 82B along I-77 in York County as "Cherry Road"

The motion was seconded by Commissioner Truluck and passed unanimously. Copies of the resolutions and the processes are included in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: Commissioner Jones reported for the Legislative Committee and made a motion that the Commission approve the recommendation of the Committee to adopt a policy that SCDOT will provide the state match for congressional earmarks, which were approved and submitted by the Commission. A further motion was made that congressional earmarks, which were not submitted in accordance with the policy, must be matched by the local government or entity that requested the earmark, unless the Commission determines on a case-by-case basis that the match should be provided by SCDOT. Commissioner Hardee seconded and the Commission passed unanimously. Commissioner Truluck voted against the recommendation in the Legislative Committee meeting but voted affirmative in the Commission meeting.

SECTION 10: Commissioner Harrell reported for the Finance Committee. Commissioner Harrell made the following motion:

"Based on notification by the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration of the actual funding levels provided by Acts of Congress, I move that the Commission adopt the revised 2006 Highway Program Funding Obligation Plan, which is a total of \$517 million including state match, and the 2006 Mass Transit Program Funding Plan, which is a total of \$37.4 million, including state funds, both of which were presented and discussed in the Finance Committee meeting today"

Commissioner Harrell also made the following motion:

"In order for staff to prepare a five-year spending plan, I move that the Commission adopt the Highway and Mass Transit Program Funding Obligation Plans for 2007 through 2009 at the same levels and allocations of funding as approved for 2006".

Commissioner Truluck seconded the motion and the Commission unanimously approved.

SECTION 11: On behalf of the Mass Transit Committee, a motion was made by Commissioner Hardee requesting approval to distribute mass transit funds as recommended by staff and shown in detail in the Appendix. The motion passed unanimously.

SECTION 12: On motion of Commissioner Jones, seconded by Commissioner Harrell, the Commission unanimously passed a motion to go into Executive Session.

EXECUTIVE SESSION


The Commission went into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing legal matters.

Surplus Property Public Notice

March 16, 2006

In accordance with the State of South Carolina Statue 57-5-340, by this publication the Department is making public the Surplus Property Real Estate Transactions to the State Highway Commission. The following sheets include a breakdown of surplus property real estate transactions. These transactions may have resulted from negotiations with property owners during right of way acquisition, direct sales, settlement of a condemnation action, and/or corrective actions to previously reported sales.

1. File 18.568 / Road S-199 (Trolley Road) / Dorchester County / Sixth District

During construction of improvements on Road S-9, under File 18.568 in Dorchester County, in the Town of Summerville, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-9, under the Beltline Act and was accepted into the State's Highway System on December 1, 1936.

A request was received from an adjacent property owner asking the Department to convey a small portion of Old Road S-9 made surplus by the Relocation of Road S-9. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. This conveyance will pay in full any damages for removing the road frontage from the Grantee's property. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.13 of an acre of land to Marlene E. Coleman was executed on December 12, 2005.

2. File 40.277A / Route I-77 / Richland County / Second District

During construction of improvements on Route I-77, under File 40.227A in Richland County, in the City of Columbia, the Department acquired right of way for Route I-77, by Title to Real Estate from Eastside Company, Inc. dated June 21, 1976 and by Title to Real Estate from Eastside Associates (a S.C. Partnership) dated August 21, 1986.

In the Department's efforts to liquidate its surplus inventory, the subject parcel was given to a real estate consultant. The property was marketed to the public with the Grantee making the highest offer. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for 2.13 acres of land to Veterans Road Properties, LLC was executed on January 9, 2006, in consideration of \$46,434.00.

3. File 25.439 / Road S-102 / Hampton County / Second District

During construction of improvements on Road S-102, under File 25.421 in Hampton County, near the Town of Varnville, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-102, by Dedication from Town of Varnville dated May 17, 1972; by Dedication from the Town of Varnville dated August 7, 1978 under Road S-102 in File 25.480; and also by Dedication from the Town of Varnville dated January 29, 1974 under Road S-102, File 25.439.

A request was received from the Town of Varnville asking the Department to convey its interest in Road S-102, which surrounds the Hampton General Hospital. The hospital plans to expand their parking areas. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Since the town has agreed to take over the maintenance of Road S-102, the Highway Commission removed the road in October 2005. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.55 acres of land to the Town of Varnville was executed on January 19, 2006.

4. File 42.318A / SC Route 296 / Spartanburg County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 296, under File 42.318A in Spartanburg County, near the Town of Reidville, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 296, by Title to Real Estate from Rhonda J. Weaver & Ruth R. Harmon (life estate) dated November 4, 2002.

In the Department's efforts to liquidate its surplus inventory, the subject parcel was given to a real estate consultant. The property was marketed to the public with the Grantee making the highest offer. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.45 of an acre of land to Huynh T. Phan & Kim loan T. Phan was executed on December 16, 2005, in consideration of \$55,000.00.

5. File 42.318A / SC Route 296 / Spartanburg County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 296, under File 42.318A in Spartanburg County, near the Town of Reidville, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 296, by Title to Real Estate from Barry E. Nigh & LaHoma A. Nigh dated October 24, 2003.

In the Department's efforts to liquidate its surplus inventory, the subject parcel was given to a real estate consultant. The property was marketed to the public with the Grantee making the highest offer. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.45 of an acre of land to Huynh T. Phan & Kim loan T. Phan was executed on December 16, 2005, in consideration of \$44,000.00.

6. File 42.125A / US Route 221 / Spartanburg County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on US Route 221, under File 42.125A in Spartanburg County, near the City of Woodruff, the Department acquired right of way for US Route 221, by Title to Real Estate from Sara L. Hindman dated August 16, 1988.

In the Department's efforts to liquidate its surplus inventory, the subject parcel was given to a real estate consultant to sell. This very small uneconomic parcel of land was offered to the adjacent property owners with the Grantee making a request to purchase the parcel for \$200.00 more than the asking price. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.218 of an acre of land to Joe E. Mitchell, Jr. was executed on October 26, 2005, in consideration of \$5,200.00.

7. File 11.491.3 / SC Route 329 / Cherokee County / Fifth District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 329, under File 11.491.3 near the City of Gaffney in Cherokee County, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 329 by Title to Real Estate from Ailene E. McGill dated October 10, 1979; by Title to Real Estate from Irabelle E. Borders dated October 18, 1979; by Title to Real Estate from Annie Mitchem dated August 21, 1979; and by Title to Real Estate from Saphees Bridges dated September 5, 1979.

The Department received a request from the adjacent property owner asking the Department to sell several small parcels of possible surplus right of way. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcels could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcels were surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.06 acres of land to Luther R. Tate was executed on January 30, 2006, in consideration of \$6,000.00.

8. File 23.277A / Route I-385 / Greenville County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on Route I-385, under File 23.227A in Greenville County, near the City of Greenville, the Department acquired right of way for Route I-385 by Title to Real Estate from Greenville Area Commission for Technical Education dated March 17, 1995; and by Condemnation from Greenville Technical Foundation Incorporated dated February 15, 1995.

In the Department's efforts to liquidate surplus property from its inventory, the subject parcel was given to a real estate consultant to market to the general public using all means necessary to attract a qualified buyer. The Grantee offered the highest acceptable offer over the appraised value. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 15 acres of land to Jones and Jones Investments, LLC was executed on February 1, 2006, in consideration of \$1,900,000.00.

9. File 30.695 / SC Route 72 / Laurens County / Third District

During construction of improvements on Road S-30, under File 30.263 in Laurens County, in the Town of Mountville, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-30 by Deed to Right of Way from C. N. Mauney dated February 23, 1949.

At the request of an adjacent landowner, a request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.42 of an acre of land to Ernest D. Teems was executed on February 17, 2006, in consideration of \$1,000.00.

10. File 30.695 / SC Route 72 / Laurens County / Third District

During construction of improvements on Road S-30, under File 30.263 in Laurens County, in the Town of Mountville, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-30 by Condemnation from A. P. Fuller dated March 31, 1949.

At the request of James M. Wham, Jr., Family Limited Partnership, the adjacent landowner, a request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 1.34 acres of land to James M. Wham, Jr. Family Limited Partnership, was executed on February 17, 2006, in consideration of \$2,800.00.

11. File 19.454 / Road S-453 / Edgefield County / Third District

During construction of improvements on Road S-453, under File 19.454 in Edgefield County, near the Town of Johnston, the Department acquired right of way for Road S-453, by Deed to Right of Way from Mount Pleasant Baptist Church dated June 16, 1978.

A request was received from the District Two office asking the Department to abandon a small portion of Road S-453 and deed to adjacent owner. The Grantee had extended their sanctuary out to the center of the existing roadbed. This action will clear the encroachment and the Department of any additional maintenance responsibility for that portion of the road as well as protect the Department from any future liability. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Edgefield County has agreed to take over the maintenance responsibility of the road. Therefore, a Gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.12 of an acre of land to Edgefield County was executed on February 17, 2006.

12. File 1.527 / SC Route 72 / Abbeville County / Third District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 72, under Project No. F.A.G.M. 15-A-(1), in Abbeville County, in the City of Abbeville, the Department acquired right of way for a portion of Brooks Street by Deed to Right of Way from William P. Greene, Jr. dated August 24, 1939.

The City of Abbeville closed this portion of Brooks Street, containing 0.196 of an acre, and conveyed the parcel to Brooks Street Properties, LLC by deed dated November 10, 2005. A request was received from the Resident Maintenance Engineer to prepare a quitclaim deed and convey any interest that SCDOT may have in the above mentioned parcel, for the purpose of clearing the title. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.196 acres of land to Brooks Street Properties, LLC was executed on February 17, 2006, in consideration of \$1,000.00.

Professional Services Recommendations

March 16, 2006

The following sheets include recommendations for the Department to utilize professional consulting firms to provide various services, which may include design, right of way acquisitions, construction engineering and inspection, or other associated services. The Department requests approval from the Commission to advertise, select and negotiate for these necessary services.

Recommendations – March 16, 2006

“On Call” Professional Travel Demand Modeling Services

The Department requests the Commission’s approval to select and negotiate with firms to provide travel demand modeling services on an “on call” basis. These services will be utilized by the office of Planning for development of long-range transportation plans, corridor studies, traffic projections, and air quality analysis.

The contract will cover a period of approximately two (2) years. Funding for these services will be provided by Federal and State funds.

"On Call" Professional Surveying Services

The Department requests Commission approval to select and negotiate with firms to provide surveying services on a statewide "on call" basis. These services will be utilized for the Preconstruction field surveying necessary for the development of highway and/or bridge projects when the projected workload exceeds the capabilities of the Department's Preconstruction Survey's Office.

The contract will cover a period of approximately three (3) years. The total estimated cost for the contract is \$125,000.00 per year. Funding for these services will be on a project-by-project basis and will be provided from various Federal and State funds.

Removal of Roads From State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends Commission approval for the removal of certain sections of secondary roads from the State Highway Secondary System. These sections of roads may be removed for one of the following reasons:

1. Abandonment of Relocated Section of Highway
2. Deletions and Removal of Roads from State Secondary System - Roads may be deleted and removed from secondary system by exchanging for equal or less mileage or roads, which have a higher traffic importance. Ownership reverts to local government having jurisdiction (city or county). Approval of deletion or removal by local government is not required.
3. Abandonment of Right-of-way - Right-of-way may be abandoned if it is determined that the right-of-way is not required for right-of-way proposes or if the right-of-way is not needed for Department purposes.
4. Court Order

Correction of Description of State Highways

The Department recommends Commission approval of the correction of the description of sections of State Highway previously added to the State Highway System. The description of roads currently in the State Highway Secondary System may be changed for relocation purposes, to revise the description of the termini to show what was actually constructed by contract, county line changes, or a change in the secondary road number.

Additions to State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends Commission approval to add sections of road to the State Highway Secondary System for construction and maintenance. The Department may add roads to the State Highway Secondary System by request of the County Transportation Committees contingent on mileage being available under the current mileage cap. Roads may be added to the State Secondary System by the construction of a new roadway, accepting existing county/city roads into our Secondary System by the swap method, or by county line changes. Roads added to the State Highway System must be constructed to Department standards or reviewed for compliance with Department standards.

Rescind Action Adding Roads to State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends the Commission rescind its previous actions adding roads to the State Highway Secondary System for construction and maintenance. The Department may rescind action on roads, which have not been constructed and formally accepted into the State Highway Secondary System. Roads may be rescinded due to right-of-way being unavailable, problems arising during construction, or funding issues.

Transfer of Road between Secondary and Primary Systems

The Department recommends Commission approval to transfer sections of road from the Secondary System to the Primary System, or vice versa. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 57-5-50 of the Code-of-Laws of South Carolina, 1976, the Commission may transfer any route or section of route from the state highway secondary system to the state highway primary system, or vice versa, when, in its judgment, such transfer is advisable to better serve the traveling public.

Detailed information concerning each of these requests is attached.







Process for the "Big Check" Ceremonies

- The municipalities contact the EPO office and request that SCDOT participate in a "Big Check" ceremony. At that time the EPO office will orally advise the municipality of the procedure to be followed in order to have SCDOT participation. The EPO office will follow up by sending the Municipality the written procedure.

Procedure:

1. The municipality provides tentative dates and location for the Big Check ceremony. There must be at least a two-week period of time between the receipt of the tentative dates and the planned ceremony. During the legislative session, the dates will be on a Monday or a Friday.
2. Immediately upon receipt of the request, the EPO office will contact the appropriate Commissioner and resident members of the legislative delegation to advise of the request for the ceremony and will coordinate the date and time based on the their schedules and the tentative dates provided by the municipality.
3. The EPO office will send written notification to the following of the location, date and time selected:

SCDOT Executive Director's Office - Attention: Executive Assistant
Appropriate Commissioner
Municipality
Resident Legislators
County Delegation Office
4. The Municipality is responsible for the location, program, photographs, press releases and any planned reception.
5. The EPO office will have the Big Checks prepared and delivered to the Municipality on or before the date of the ceremony.

6. If the Commissioner cannot attend, SCDOT will assure that an agency representative will attend the event and will be prepared to make remarks.

Internal Operations:

- EPO office will establish and maintain a spreadsheet with confirmed ceremony dates for each Commissioner.
- Once the check has been mounted and laminated, the District Office and/or local offices are contacted by Communications to assist with transporting the "Big Check" to the appropriate municipality.

SCDOT PROCESS FOR NAMING ROADS AND BRIDGES

CONCURRENT RESOLUTIONS PASSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

1. Concurrent Resolutions are received in the Executive Director's Office and given to the Executive Assistant
2. The Executive Assistant forwards a copy of the resolution to Traffic Engineering to determine if the road or bridge has been previously named and to coordinate with the Legal Division for a determination whether there are any legal impediments.
3. Once clearance is received from Traffic Engineering, The Executive Assistant will forward a copy of the resolution to the Chairman of the Invitations and Resolutions Commission Committee and request approval to place the resolution on the agenda for review by the Invitations and Resolutions Committee. If complications are reported, an appropriate letter will be prepared for the Chairman of the Invitations and Resolutions Committee to the sponsor of the resolution.
4. If approved by the Invitations and Resolutions Committee, it will then be presented to the full Commission for approval.
5. Upon Commission approval, the Executive Assistant to the Executive Director will contact the sponsor of the resolution to determine if a ceremony is requested and will advise the sponsor that DOT will request funding for the sign from the appropriate CTC and will coordinate a ceremony date if one is requested with their appropriate contact. He/she will also be advised that the Department will install the signs, maintain the site, and assist with any other transportation related matters but the ceremony itself will be the responsibility of the resolution sponsors. The Executive Assistant will determine who the resolution sponsor contact will be at this time and will provide the name of SCDOT's designated coordinator. (The SCDOT designated coordinator list will be provided to the Executive Assistant by the State Highway Engineer.)
6. The Executive Assistant to the Executive Director will then prepare a letter from Ms. Mabry per above findings to the sponsor of the resolution, copying the Chairman of the Invitations and Resolutions Committee, the appropriate commissioner, the State Highway Engineer, and the designated coordinator. The attached form will be prepared and sent to the State Highway Engineer along with a copy of the letter and resolution.
7. The State Highway Engineer or his designee will forward a copy of the resolution to the designated coordinator and the Project Development

Engineer and direct them to request that the appropriate CTC be contacted for funding for fabrication and installation of the signs or for concurrence for funding, whichever is appropriate. At this time, a tracking number will be assigned.

- 8 A. Once the CTC check or concurrence is received, the Project Development Engineer will program the maximum \$500 from CTC funds and notify the designated coordinator. The designated coordinator will then request the District Engineering Administrator to fabricate the appropriate signs, and contact the resolution sponsor for details about installing the signs or ceremony assistance. The designated coordinator will coordinate with the District Engineering Administrator in erecting the signs, maintaining the site, and any other transportation related matters. Actual ceremony planning, programs, invitations, resolution framings, pictures, and receptions are the responsibility of the Delegation.
- 8 B. If the CTC does not allocate the appropriate funds, the Project Development Engineer will notify the designated coordinator who will contact the sponsor of the resolution and advise that funding has not been allocated.
9. The designated coordinator will notify the Executive Assistant of the details of the ceremony to be placed on the Special Events Calendar and furnished to the Executive Director and Commissioners.
10. Once the ceremony is complete (if ceremony is not requested, once the signs are installed), the original resolution form will be returned by the coordinator to the State Highway Engineer for clearing the tracking number. The resolution form will then be forwarded to the Executive Assistant to close out the file on the resolution.

The same process will be followed on SCDOT Commission resolutions with the exception of:

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:






Mass Transit Federal Allocation
