On first shift, he works at Wal-Mart. On second shift he works at O'Charley's, across the street. He rides the bus to work, in the mornings & gets a ride home, at night. What I'm asking is, if you please help him at least get his provisional license, so he can get to work & home. His uncle has the truck he had, holding it for him, til he gets his license back. I hope & pray, you will help him.

My nephew is Christopher Clayton Rollins. He is in jail now, for failing to charge his monitor. This is his story. His parents used drugs & drank. And probably still do. When he was 14 years old, he supposedly done something to his cousin, while their parents were doing drugs. Her father was the drug dealer, so his mother, turned her son in to police, for a drug deal. Yes, I know it sounds crazy. But it's true. So Chris. goes to jail

at 14, serves his time, gets tagged as a sex offender. He done his time, as a grievor. When he gets out, he gets a wife has three kids. And loves them very much and wants to see them. So this story goes. He's been in jail so many times. Mostly because of his monitor. Can you please help him. He may be mentally disturbed, because of the drugs that he grew up in. I don't know. His parents treated him, worse than they'd treat a dog. His mother's been married 3 times. His step father really abused him, worse than his mother. He was 14 years old. Someone could have helped him, instead of putting him in jail. It seems like everytime he gets up, he gets stomped back down. He may not even know how to help himself, mentally. I don't know. He had a job, a place to stay. Was even gonna get a maped to ride. Then he winds up in jail again, because he didn't change his monitor. Can you please, PARDON this man & set him FREE? Can someone please help him? I'm begging you please, for both of them.

I don't understand how, you can put dope heads in jail & they get out the next day. And he has to stay in there for a year, because of a monitor. While drug heads get out and do the same thing. They could be a lot of tax payers money saved. Please don't let him be just a number, and no one cares.

He really does try to make it. I'm his Aunt, and I think my family is the only one that cares about him. His own Mama, my sister, doesn't even care. He's tried so many times to make it right with her, but she just keeps on kicking him down. That is really sad. We love Chris & help him all we can. But we can't do that so much.

That's why I'm asking for your help. Please.
