Last month, the National Association of Area Agencies on Aging (n4a) [awarded six volunteer team awards](#). Here is one program's story.

An all-volunteer team of 25 older adults initially developed by the [Pima Council on Aging](#) has linked thousands of prospective volunteers with 83 community-based agencies in Green Valley-Sahuarita, AZ and produced a \$1.87 million return on investment last year for the program and community. Now considered a major recruiter of volunteers and trainer of volunteer coordinators, the [Green Valley-Sahuarita Volunteer Clearinghouse \(GVSVC\)](#) project gives purpose and assistance to older adults.
