The SC Confederate flag law allows the flag currently flying over the State House Complex to be taken down immediately. The decision appears not to be yours or the Legislature, but that of a Budget & Control Board Maintenance Man.

The flag law states that "the Division of General Services of the Budget and Control Board, or its successor in interest,..... shall replace the flags at appropriate intervals as may be necessary due to wear."

So, if the flag looks worn, it can be replaced. And the law does not state when the replacement flag has to be mounted on that flag pole.
