H.3204 – Bernstein – Cervical Cancer Prevention Act – House Calendar

12/18/2014 version

- Beginning in the 2015-16 school year, DHEC may offer the cervical cancer vaccination series for adolescent students enrolling in 7th grade, in public or private schools.
- No student is required to have the vaccine before enrolling in school.
- Allows DHEC to create a brochure talking about the vaccine (starting at the 6th grade) to be distributed in schools, but requires the brochure to state that the vaccine is optional.
- The brochure may be distributed to 6th grade students at the beginning of the school year.
- Implementation of the act is contingent upon state or federal appropriations to fully cover the costs of providing the vaccine to eligible students as well as the funds to provide the informational brochure
