My name is Kenneth Wilson Parker, 208 Forest St. Clover, SC, 29710, 8036105786

On March 19th 2014 I was arrested by the Clover, SC police, charged with Driving Under Suspension and sent to Moss Justice Center. I was NOT driving under suspension. I had been very ill and my license had been suspended but I had obtained a license after paying my fines. This license was in my possession. I had additional fines to pay by March 13th which I paid on March 12th, and I have the receipts to prove it.

The Clover police said that there was an outstanding warrant based on DMV records for me. How could that be? The fines were processed electronically, so a week later should have been in the system.

I had to hire a lawyer, Ms. Burris of the Burris Legal group. She was able to work out a plea in which my status was changed to DUS 1st offense and no HTO. Unfortunately, I had to hire a driver, Geneva Gail Steele, who turned out to be a two-time felon and con artist. She kept me, through subterfuge and theft from paying my fine of \$652.50. She was embezzling my money, which she was ostensibly holding to pay my upcoming alimony on July 29th. She had been appointed by the Probate Court to have my power of attorney and to be my guardian. I had been very ill and I had been driving when I shouldn't have. She was the ultimate con-artist. She conned the police in York County, and in Charlotte, NC.

The initial report I had made to York County was never acted upon. In fact, two other persons defrauded me but York County would take no action against them. Consequently, in desperation, I drove my old car when I shouldn't have, having someone who wanted to purchase it. I was stopped again and now face prison time for DUS 3rd and HTO (a felony).

Everything that happened to me resulted from the illegal arrest on March 19th. It has cost me my home, my car and my job. I now live on Social Security.

I intend to file a lawsuit against the DMV as soon as I can obtain the money.

I know that the DMV's actions and those of the Clover police were not intentional, but the procedures are not designed to prevent this. This has ruined my life.
