Division of State Information Technology (DSIT) is pleased to host a FREE 2-day 'Insider Threats' Workshop on August 14-15, 2012, at DSIT, 4430 Broad River Road from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. This training is offered by way of a federal grant and will be conducted by Carnegie Mellon University instructors with a focus on three types of insider threats targeted: IT sabotage, theft of intellectual property and fraud.
