The Budget Commission met in the Governor's office at 11:30 A.M., all members being present except the Governor, who was represented by Mr. John K. Cauthen.

The Commission resumed consideration of the budget requests and discussed the policies which would govern its recommendations to the General Assembly thereon.

In view of the fact that Senator Maybank had participated in the work of the Budget Commission throughout the fall, it was decided that the Commission should go to Washington and meet with him there before final action on its recommendations. It was agreed that these meetings should be held in Washington on December 16 and 17th, if necessary.

The Commission then adjourned.
