WHEREAS, our nation's more than 200,000 dental assistants play a vital role in providing quality dental health care to the American public; and

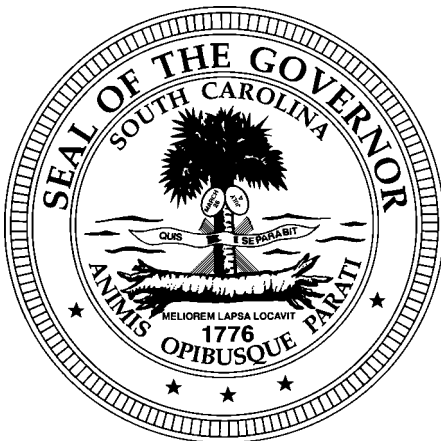
