Legal – MOX:

Today, DOE asked the court to delay our summary judgment motion until the court has decided DOE's motion to dismiss. We objected because obviously we want the court to hear our arguments about summary judgment at the same time that it hears DOE's motion to dismiss and not to delay our motion.

DHEC – Mt. Pleasant Deep Water Dock Permitting Issue:

Rick Medlin, CEO of Fruit of the Loom, contacted our office to make us aware of a dispute between DHEC and members of his Mt. Pleasant neighborhood regarding the permitting process for a deep water dock. We have contacted DHEC staff who admitted they did not follow proper notification standards. DHEC has remedied their error and has sent notification, including the opportunity for appeal, to the affected individuals. DHEC will keep us up to date on the situation.

Criminal Justice Academy – Director Harrell:

Today, Chief Keel let us know that the Director of the CJA, Hubert Harrell, is retiring (served for eight years). He has had a career in the military prior to his career in law enforcement and wants to spend more time with family. The Director is hired and overseen by the Law Enforcement Training Council. Chief Keel would like the Governor, if possible, to present Mr. Harrell with the Order of the Palmetto as a surprise. Staff will follow up on this request.
