



Dacusville Farm Days Labor Day Weekend

Marking the last long weekend of the summer season is Dacusville Farm Days. Saturday through Monday, August 31 to September 2, 2002, is Dacusville's big annual event.

Sponsored by the Robinson Family, the event will feature all types of farm equipment including a steam engine, antique cars, other antique engines and tractors, a saw mill, and a veneer mill. Visitors, young and old, will have the opportunity to step back in time to see wheat threshing as well as to experience riding in a wagon or participating in a peddle tractor pull, maybe for the first time in their lives. There will also be country, bluegrass, and gospel music, country cooking, and children's games.

The show officially opens at 9 a.m. on Saturday, August 31, and ends on Monday afternoon, September 2, 2002. A parade of tractors will be held several times during the 3-day event.

Admission is \$5 per person. Children under 12 are free.

Commissioner's Column

Hay, Look in the *Market Bulletin*!

South Carolina has been in a drought since 1998. Every year, we say, "If we can only wait until next year. We're bound to get normal weather next year." But, next year for the last few years has not brought us needed rain.

As of July 2002, total amount of rainfall for the 5-year period was 20" to 65" below normal. Except for a few counties, which are in a severe drought status, most of the state remains at the extreme level.

Voluntary water use restrictions are in place. More forest fires have occurred this year and Pine Beetle infestations are more prevalent because of the drought. Fire hydrants, man-made wells, and even artesian wells in some areas are dry. Ponds are drying up, and low oxygen levels are putting stress on fish and other pond residents.

Agriculturally, the damage has been done to corn and other row crops. Livestock are now consuming their winter supply of feed and forage. With shortages of feed, it's likely that there will be a lot of cattle on the market. In some areas 2nd or 3rd cuttings of hay have not or will not happen this year. In other areas, hay and grain is still plentiful, at least for the time being.

Since South Carolina is a hay-deficit state, even in a normal year farmers would need to buy hay that comes from outside the state at some point in time. The problem is that over half of the nation is also in a drought situation, so asking for outside help for hay is not as feasible as it was in the drought South Carolina experienced 16 years ago. States that helped us then, like the Midwestern states particularly Nebraska and the Dakotas, are also in desperate shape.

The short-term solution is to put South Carolina buyer and South Carolina seller together, and that's where the *Market Bulletin* is a valuable tool. In order to assist livestock owners in the state, especially cattle and horse owners, with their hay needs, the South Carolina Department of Agriculture publishes a list of "hay and grain for sale" in the *Market Bulletin*. As of the August 1st publication, 58 hay and grain ads were listed for 21 counties of the state.

The South Carolina market for hay and grain should work as long as it can. Hauling hay into the state means higher prices for farmers due to transportation costs, etc. So, while hay and grain is still available here in the state, we just need to put our buyers and sellers together.

Please check the current *Market Bulletin* "hay and grain for sale" list. We will continue to update the list every two weeks. If you have or your neighbor has hay for sale, please list it with us in the *Market Bulletin*.

Those who can't find hay in their area should look in the *Market Bulletin* or call the SCDA for assistance in finding those who do have hay for sale in South Carolina. Or, they can log on to <http://www.scda.state.sc.us> and click on *Market Bulletin* to look for "hay and grain for sale."

In addition to using the *Market Bulletin* as a resource for buying and selling South Carolina hay, since South Carolina was declared a drought disaster state in March, the USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) has several programs available for hay and grain and for low interest loans. Climate and weather officials tell us that we should not expect any appreciable rainfall until this winter. In the meantime, we as South Carolinians must continue to restrict our water use and think about solutions for the future, have patience and fortitude, and do whatever we can, collectively and individually, to keep our water supply safe and secure.

But, the best thing we can do right now is to pray that the Lord will guide us through this current drought ordeal and for the wisdom to find ways to be proactive in future drought emergencies.
