



SC Counties Approved for Emergency Conservation Program Funds

Twenty-two counties in South Carolina have been approved for Emergency Conservation Program (ECP) funding, according to Laurie Lawson, USDA-Farm Service Agency State Executive Director. ECP funds will be used to provide emergency water for livestock and orchards. The counties approved are: Abbeville, Aiken, Anderson, Berkeley, Charleston, Cherokee, Chester, Edgefield, Fairfield, Greenville, Greenwood, Kershaw, Lancaster, Laurens, McCormick, Newberry, Oconee, Pickens, Saluda, Spartanbur g, Williamsburg, and York. An Emergency Conservation Program sign-up is being held for these counties from August 1st through August 31st. Livestock (confined and non-confined) and orchard producers in these counties suffering severe water shortages should immediately contact their local Farm Service Agency office.

USDA to Assist Tobacco Growers/Allotment Holders

As directed by Congress, the USDA-Farm Service Agency will distribute \$340 million to tobacco growers and allotment holders who suffered a reduction of tobacco quota or acreage for the 1999-2000 crop years. Eligible kinds of tobacco include: flue-cured types 11-14, burley type 31, fire-cured type 21, and cigar filler/binder types 54-55.

While the USDA does not pay direct subsidies to tobacco farmers, the amount of U.S. tobacco produced is regulated to match supply and demand with a guaranteed minimum price for producers. In recent years, allotments and quotas for some kinds of tobacco have been significantly reduced.

Sign-up at local USDA Farm Service Agency offices began July 31, 2000, and will end on September 1, 2000. Payments will reach farmers between October 1-20, 2000. Individual farm payments will be allocated evenly between farmers and quota owners for flue-cured and cigar/binder tobaccos. For burley and fire-cured tobaccos, the payments will be split three ways between farmers, quota owners, and those in control of the quotas. FSA will publish program rules in the Federal Register before issuing the payments.

Pork Perception Changed by Producer Checkoff

In the 1950s, pork producers realized that consumers were becoming more and more concerned about diet and health and demanded leaner pork. Producers turned their attention to producing a leaner, slimmer hog to meet that demand. Thanks to the effort of research and education, hogs today are raised leaner, and a pork loin now has 77% less fat and 53% fewer calories.

In the 1980s, pork producers realized that the old perception of pork was still in the minds of consumers. They realized the need to show that their product had changed and that the new, leaner pork was an essential part of a healthy diet. In 1986 producers joined forces and established the U.S. pork checkoff program with Congressional approval of the Pork Promotion, Research and Consumer Information Act of 1985. The checkoff program worked. Pork was repositioned, and consumers began including pork in their diets, once again.

Pork checkoff programs have helped raise that awareness of and demand for pork products. The checkoff-funded "Pork. The Other White Meat" is recognized by more than 86% of consumers as one of the 10 most memorable advertising campaigns. The program has also helped reposition pork in the minds of consumers, increasing pork consumption by 5 pounds per person in the past five years. A record 54.2 pounds of pork are now consumed per person annually.

In addition, checkoff-funded food-service programs have helped pork become the fastest growing meat category in the nation's restaurants and have increased foodservice use of pork by 17%. More than 54% of all of the nation's pork is used in foodservice.

The checkoff program also provides tools for all producers to create opportunities for themselves. Checkoff dollars are invested in research projects that target solutions to producer problems. And, producer education programs make the latest technology and information available to all producers.

The current U.S. checkoff rate is 45 cents per \$100 value. In other words, for every hundred dollars in hog sales, 45 cents is set aside by producers for the U.S. checkoff program. The National Pork Board, composed of pork producers, is responsible for the collection, distribution, and program accountability of the pork industry checkoff. Persons nominated by pork producers to serve on the National Pork Board are appointed for three-year terms by the USDA Secretary of Agriculture.

Collections and reports are remitted monthly to the National Pork Board. These reports must state the number of hogs marketed, the gross value of marketings, the amount of assessments made, and the state of origin of the marketed animals.

The National Pork Board contracts with industry organizations to execute specific programs in the areas of promotion, research, and consumer information. No funds may be used for lobbying or to influence government policy. The SC Pork Board is the organization in SC responsible for executing the program in this state.

A 12-member body, the SC Pork Board elected by pork producers to initiate programs that ensure the most efficient use of producer checkoff dollars. Established by the Agricultural Commodities Marketing Act, the SC Pork Board focuses on pork promotion, consumer information, education, and research. The Pork Board has implemented the School Lunch Challenge to create nutritional menus using pork that school children will like and eat. Additional

investments of producer checkoff funds are being used to identify solutions for odor and environmental problems that are economically viable at the farm level. Cooperative efforts are also underway to deliver information to producers for the efficient production and marketing of pork and to provide the necessary resources to make them more efficient and profitable. In 1998, hog prices reached rock bottom at 8¢ a pound. To cover production costs or to break even, a hog farmer must receive approximately 40¢ per pound at the market. Today, prices are somewhat better, but there is still much left to do in the areas of marketing, research, and education for the industry to continue to be successful.

To those of you who are part of the 86% who recognize that pork is "the other white meat" because of the checkoff campaign, I encourage you to continue to buy pork for a healthy diet. Remember this rule of thumb: The leanest cuts of pork have the word "loin" in the name. Support the pork industry and all of agriculture in the state by buying the best---SC Quality products!

To all pork producers, I urge you to take time to vote in this national referendum. They say that if you don't cast your vote, you have no right to cast stones. So, it's important to you, your industry, and your livelihood that your voice be heard. So, contact your local Farm Service Agency for more information.
