Cemetery consists of approximately 60 markers on a large hilltop parcel. The site is bounded by a thin line of trees and vegetation to the west, southwest, and south. Grave markers are common types with no elaborate or exceptional funerary art in evidence. Observed date ranges on markers are 1918 to present but there may be older grave markers as the associated church was founded ca. 1890. Unmarked graves may also be present.
