To accommodate increased customer demand, KION will be investing \$5.7 million in its existing operations, creating more than 50 new jobs over the next five years.

Headquartered at 2450 West 5th Street in Summerville, S.C., the company's Dorchester County expansion will allow it to increase its production capacity from 3,000 units per year in 2015 to approximately 12,000 units per year by 2020.
