Subject: DSS Update

Keith provided me with the following update:

1. The first restore continues to run and is at 60% completion. It should finish Friday afternoon.
2. Work continues to progress with the new file format and the empty database. DSS application folks have cleaned, purged, and moved data for the months of April, May, and June. They should complete March by in the morning and may have February and January completed by then. DSS plans to go live tomorrow morning with this new file format and database. They are field testing it today and it seems to be working. They will continue to clean, purge, and move data from previous months after the go live.
3. Dept. of Admin staff developed a stop gap backup for the new application and implemented it last night. They are now developing a short term solution that DSS can use for a few months. Ultimately, we will work with DSS on a long term solution to migrate them to a more current version of a backup and restore system and to also put a redundant box at Clemson for a true disaster recovery solution.

I believe that DSS is satisfied with the progress of the teams. Susan, if you have any concerns or think there are additional items we should consider, please let me know. By the way, Keith says your application staff has been top notch and really jumped in to develop and make the new file format work.
