Thank you for writing the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services regarding information on programs in South Carolina to assist you following the completion of your incarceration.

Our agency administers Medicaid, which is a healthcare program. To qualify for Medicaid, an individual must meet both federal and state financial and categorical requirements. A Medicaid eligibility worker can determine if you qualify based on the information provided from an application if you decide to apply. We have enclosed an overview of the Medicaid program, as well as, material on other healthcare options. If you have access to the Internet you may also want to visit our website at www.dhhs.state.sc.us.

While Medicaid does not provide financial assistance to pay for food, housing, utility bills, or other living expenses, we have included a list of state agencies that may be able help to you. You may also wish to contact charitable or non-profit organizations in the South Carolina County where you intend to reside.
