The United States of America Declaration of War Against Terrorist September 3, 2014

Section 1

America reserves the right to eliminate terrorist in the territory of the United States and Internationally without consideration of what country or territory they may be located in.

Section 2

America reserves the right to use whatever method it considers appropriate and available to eliminate terrorist.

Section 3

All persons requesting permission to enter or re-enter the United States who have been identified as visiting a terrorist area, without proper clearance, will be denied entrance.

Section 4

All persons attempting to travel to a terrorist area, without proper clearance, who have been identified as a security risk will have their passports\visas revoked.

Section 5

All visas will be revoked or denied to individuals, without proper clearance, wanting to come to America from countries with known active terrorist cells.

Section 6

Under a rule of war the President of the United States as Commander in Chief must reactive all military sources to combat and destroy all major terrorist units who have the capability to do harm to America and its citizens.

Section 7

Under a rule of war the Department of Defense will increase and mobilize our military forces in all branches to provide support in destroying terrorist throughout the world.

Section 8

Under a rule of war Homeland Security is required to increase personnel and equipment to a level that will prevent border crossings. Closing of our borders, not just secure them, to all unauthorized people attempting to cross over from another country illegally is required.

Section 9

Under a rule of war security forces in all ports of entry will be increased and trained to recognize potential human threats, regardless of gender, ethnicity, culture or status.

Section 10

Under a rule of war the United States Coast Guard personnel and equipment will be increased to deter unauthorized individuals from entering the United States.

Section 11

Under a rule of war, establish a system of identifying, tracking and prosecuting all persons who promote and instigate the harming of America and its citizens.

Section 12

Under a rule of war, establish an anti-terrorist Social Media propaganda policy to counter their strategy. Shut down or block all Social Media blogs advocating the destruction of America and the encouragement of Americans joining a terrorist group.

Section 13

This declaration will continue in force until a two-thirds vote both in the Senate and House repeal it.
