Sumter Disaster Recovery Center Temporarily Closes Saturday

What: The disaster recovery center in Sumter will close temporarily Saturday.

Where: The center located at 700 West Liberty St. in Sumter will relocate to a location that is to be determined. The new location will be announced as soon as confirmed.

When: Temporary close 7 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 21 and reopen at a time to be determined. If survivors need assistance registering or have questions about disaster assistance they may call 800-621-3362 from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. They can also locate their closest center by visiting asd.fema.gov/inter/locator/home.htm.
