SECTION 1: The Minutes for the meeting of June 19, 1991; copies of which have been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 2: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase orders issued for amounts in excess of \$10,000.00 during the month of June, 1991, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates to provide Phase 1 environmental and preliminary engineering services for the Mark Clark Expressway in Charleston County at an estimated cost of \$1,875,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into a supplemental agreement with HDR Engineering, Inc. to provide additional engineering services to prepare plans and specifications for a dual bridge on the S. E. Beltway overpass over S. C. 12 in Richland County at an anticipated cost of \$96,386.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into supplemental agreement No. 3 with Wilbur Smith Associates, Inc. to provide additional geotechnical services for bridge design in Berkeley and Williamsburg counties at an estimated cost of \$93,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the City of Rock Hill to enter into a supplemental agreement with LPA Group/Campco Engineering for additional engineering services for Dave Lyle Boulevard at an estimated cost of \$304,117.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into supplemental agreement No. 7 with Kimley-Horn and Associates to provide additional survey and design services for the Hilton Head Cross Island Parkway at an estimated cost of \$262,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into supplemental agreement No. 9 with Stevens & Wilkinson to provide redesign of the weigh-in-motion stations in Dorchester and Spartanburg counties, at a cost of \$67,660.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to advertise and select a consulting engineering firm to provide preliminary engineering services for a bridge structure in Berkeley-Georgetown counties at an estimated cost of \$1,260,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion extending the current contract with D. E. Sumpter and Associates to continue to provide the present level of services to the DBE firms at a maximum cost of \$44,000, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 11: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with South Carolina State College to conduct a workshop on preventative maintenance for transportation providers in South Carolina, at a contract maximum of \$13,672.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 12: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with CGA Consulting Services, Inc. to conduct a State Elderly and Specialized Needs Assessment and a Statewide Coordination Plan, at a contract maximum of \$69,911.60, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 13: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into supplemental agreement with ATE Management and Service Company, Inc. to move the statewide public transportation plan forward, extend the existing agreement with ATE Management through 1992 and add approved/available funds to support implementation at a cost not to exceed \$391,949.00, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 14: The Commission unanimously passed a motion correcting the description of a recommendation approved at the June 19, 1991 Commission meeting to show the correct funding source and amount for the UTAP Program, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 15: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report of the Department concerning the execution of a quitclaim deed dated April 16, 1991 conveying 3,150 square feet parcel of land on SC Route 61 Expressway in Charleston County to C. J. Shahid, Jr. for the consideration of \$315.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 16: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report of the Department concerning the execution of a quitclaim deed dated June 4, 1991 conveying 0.08 acre parcel of land on Route S-1677 in Richland County to South Carolina Real Estate Development Company, Inc. for the consideration of \$4,975.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 17: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report of the Department concerning the execution of a quitclaim deed dated June 12, 1991 conveying 3,300 square feet parcel of land on SC Route 61 Expressway in Charleston County to C. J. Shahid, Jr. for the consideration of \$330.00, as shown in the Appendix.

The Department requests Commission approval to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 7 with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. to provide additional survey and design services relating to recent alignment and toll plaza decisions.

The additional service is estimated to cost \$262,000.00 and will be funded with SHIMS funds.

CONSULTANT - PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING SERVICES

The Department requests Commission approval to advertise for and select a consulting engineering firm to provide Preliminary Engineering services to prepare plans and specifications for a bridge structure in Berkeley-Georgetown Counties.

The bridge structure would be the replacement of the US 17A/SC 41 bridge over the Santee River.

The estimated cost for the preliminary engineering services would be approximately \$1,260,000. Federal Bridge Rehabilitation and Replacement (FBRR) funds would be involved.

Recommendation 7/18/91

To request an extension of the current contract with D. E. Sumpter and Associates (DESA, Inc.) to continue to provide the present level of services to the DBE firms during the final period of developing the Request for Proposal (RFP) and awarding the new contracts.

The extension period of performance will be from August 1, 1991, through October 31, 1991, not to exceed ninety (90) days or upon the award of the proposed contracts whichever occurs first. The cost will not exceed \$44,000 (regular Supportive Services \$6,354 per month and State Developmental Services \$8,059 per month), a maximum of three months or \$43,240.

AGREEMENT WITH SOUTH CAROLINA STATE COLLEGE

It is recommended that the Commission authorize the Department to enter into an agreement with South Carolina State College to conduct a two and 1/2-day workshop on preventative maintenance for transportation providers in South Carolina. The maximum contract amount of \$13,672 is requested to be approved through available UMTA Section 18/Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) 100% federal funding.

This activity would be conducted to augment the Department's RTAP Training Program and South Carolina State College's Transportation Technology Transfer Service which is co-sponsored with Clemson University.

AGREEMENT WITH CGA CONSULTING SERVICES, INC.

At the June 18, 1987 and June 15, 1989, meetings of the Commission, the Department was given authorization in its Public Transportation Program of Projects to conduct a State Elderly and Specialized Transportation Needs Assessment and to develop a Statewide Coordination Plan (Item #: 20 (FY'87) and Item No: 129 (FY '89). The authorizations allowed for the expenditure of a total of \$70,000 to be used for this purpose. Funding sources approved for the project were UMTA/Section 8 (\$20,000) and State Highway Funds (50,000) for a total of \$70,000.

With this approval, a bid solicitation, review and selection process was conducted through the Budget and Control Board's Materials Management Office (MMO) and the Department's Purchasing Division to secure consultant services for the above project. The MMO has concluded that CGA Consulting Services, Inc., submitted the most responsive and responsible proposal.

Therefore, it is recommended that the Commission authorize the Department to enter into an agreement with CGA Consulting Services, Inc., to conduct a State Elderly and Specialized Needs Assessment and to develop a Statewide Coordination Plan for a contract maximum not to exceed \$69,911.60.

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH ATE MANAGEMENT AND SERVICE COMPANY

At the 6/18/91, 6/21/90 and 11/16/89 meetings of the Commission, the Department was given authorization to enter into an agreement with ATE Management and Service Company for consultant services to conduct a public transportation ridership profile and marketing/promotional planning project. After receiving the authorization, the Department entered into an agreement with the ATE Management & Service Company to conduct the above tasks. The market research and promotion plan design have been completed and the promotional design is ready for implementation. In the procurement process and in the agreement with the Contractor, project continuation to implement the design was allowed given the Department's satisfaction with the Contractor's work, products, and should funding be available. The Contractor has complied fully with the initial agreement and the Department finds the work completed satisfactory. Some of the additional funding has been approved for implementing the Statewide promotion plan. The total cost for implementing the design will be \$749,253. Given the cost involved, the Department proposes implementation of this project in phases, as funds become available. Currently, there are \$391,949 approved to fund the project.

The project is aimed at promoting public transportation at the State and local levels to increase ridership, increase State-level and local community support, and improve the overall public image, understanding, benefits, and awareness of public transportation services Statewide, reduce traffic congestion and encourage ridesharing.

It is, therefore, requested that the Commission authorize the Department to enter into an agreement with the ATE Management and Service Company, Inc., to move the Statewide public transportation promotion plan forward -- extending the existing agreement with the ATE Management & Service Company through 1992 and adding approved/available funds funding to support the implementation (not to exceed \$391,949). AMENDMENT TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FY '91-'92 PROGRAM OF PROJECTSRE: Urban Transit Assistance Program

At the Commission's June 20, 1991 meeting, the Department's FY '91-'92 Public Transportation Program of Projects was approved. Included in the authorization was Item #:PT-295 which dealt with an Urban Transit Assistance Program (UTAP). The program will allow the Department to implement a transit training scholarship program benefitting urban providers. While non-urbanized providers can utilize the Department's Rural Transit Assistance Program (100% UMTA-funded), urban providers may not due to federal regulations of the Urban Mass Transit Administration. UTAP will provide a means by which urban providers can reap the same training benefits as rural ones to improve operations productivity. Inadvertently, the source of funding and amount for the UTAP program were incorrectly stated in the Program of Projects. The incorrect source was State Highway Funds and the amount in err was \$1,200.

It is, therefore, recommended that the Commission approve the correction of the following funding source (SGF) and amount (\$10,800) for implementation of the Urban Transit Assistance Program (UTAP) benefitting urban providers.

RECOMMENDATION TO CANCEL CONTRACT
IN CHARLESTON COUNTY

On November 7, 1990, the Department received bids on S. C. File No. 10.197A - F. A. Project No. HES-8810(02) - Charleston County - (Road Work). The Commission approved this project for award at its meeting on November 15, 1990 and it was awarded to Banks Construction Co., Inc., of Charleston, S. C. on December 7, 1990 in the amount of \$236,562.43.

Due to adverse public reaction, the contract was cancelled by the State Highway Engineer effective January 14, 1991. No work was performed on the contract and there are no plans to readvertise the project for bids in the future.

Therefore, it is recommended that the Commission concur in termination of the above contract by the Department.
