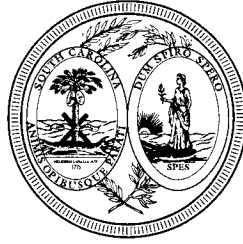

**NOTICE OF DISSOLUTION  
OF THE FLORENCE COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT  
PURSUANT TO SECTION 4-11-290 OF THE CODE OF LAWS  
OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, AS AMENDED**

1. On March 5, 2014, the Secretary of State received a Petition for Dissolution of the Florence County Fire District.
2. The Florence County Fire District is a special purpose district created and established by Act 1817 of 1972 of the South Carolina General Assembly, for the provision of fire protection service in unincorporated areas of Florence County.
3. The existing boundaries of the District as provided in Act 1817 as are as follows:

Subdistrict No. 1: "all that area of School District No. 1 of Florence County lying south and west of the following line: Beginning at the point on the Florence-Darlington County line where Highway 356 intersects with such county line, thence southerly along Highway 356 with its intersection with Highway 343, thence southerly along Highway 343 to the point where the city limits of the City of Florence crosses such road, thence easterly and southerly along such city limits to the point where such city limits cross Highway 13, thence easterly along Highway 13 to its intersection with Highway 24, thence southerly along Highway 24 to its intersection with Highway 642, thence easterly along Highway 642 to the point where such highway turns in a northerly direction toward the Kraft Board Plant, thence continuing in a direct easterly direction from such point to the Florence-Marion County line at the Great Pee Dee River."

Subdistrict No. 3: "all that area lying in [Florence County] School District No. 3" not a part of South Lynches Fire District.


Subdistrict No. 4: "all that area lying in [Florence County] School District No. 4."

Subdistrict No. 5: "all that area lying in [Florence County] School District No. 5."

Subdistrict No. 6: "all that area lying north and west of the line referred to in the description of Subdistrict No. 1

4. The Secretary of State has determined that the Florence County Fire District must be dissolved pursuant to Section 4-11-290 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, as amended.
5. The Order for Dissolution is available for inspection at the Office of the Florence County Clerk of Court.

6. The Order of Dissolution will become final on the twenty-first day following the final publication of this Notice of Dissolution.
