I am hoping the budget will be passed today. If so, I can prepare a more complete NGA. I had said in our meeting that HCBS would remain the same as FY13 if no additional funding was approved. It would increase if additional funds were appropriated. The only change would probably be a 10% match on ACE Bingo and HCBS to agree with the Title III match requirement. If the latest numbers hold, we will receive an additional 3M for HCBS and 3M nonrecurring for respite. There would also be some additional admin \$'s.
