Adult Mental Health First Aid is an 8-hour course that helps the public identify, understand and respond to signs of mental illnesses and substance abuse disorders. Just as CPR training helps a layperson without medical training assist an individual following a heart attack, Mental Health First Aid training helps a layperson assist someone experiencing a mental health crisis. After completion of the entire course, trainees will be certified as Mental Health First Aiders.

Youth Mental Health First Aid

Youth Mental Health First Aid is designed to teach parents, family members, caregivers, teachers, school staff, peers, neighbors, health and human services workers, and other caring citizens how to help an adolescent (age 12-18) who is experiencing a mental health or addiction challenge, or is in crisis. After completion, trainees will be certified as Mental Health First Aiders.
