RE: Pleasant Hill Road (S-114) - Greenville County

Dear Mrs. Gerstenberger:

Thank you for your recent request to Governor Nikki Haley concerning the condition of Pleasant Hill Road (S-114) in Greenville County. Members of my staff have investigated your request and I offer the following assessment.

Pleasant Hill Road is a state maintained, non-Federal Aid secondary road. Portions of this road are paved, but the portion which you are inquiring about is an unimproved, gravel road which does not qualify for Federal funding. Unfortunately, SCDOT does not have a dedicated funding source for paving of unimproved, gravel roads. SCDOT has historically relied on the County Transportation Committees (CTC) to address this particular area of need as funding is available.

As per your conversation with District Maintenance Engineer Jason Allison, our maintenance crews will repair the potholes in the gravel portion of Pleasant Hill Road and inspect the ditches to ensure they are functioning properly. They will also continue to monitor the condition of Pleasant Hill Road until such time that more permanent improvements can be made.

I recommend you contact the Greenville County CTC at 864-467-7105 to advocate for the paving of the unimproved segment of the road.
