Hunting Island State Park was greatly affected by Hurricane Irma earlier this week. Most of the damage was caused by flooding from the storm surge and heavy rains. Park Director Gaines and our state park team have assessed the damage and provided the photos below. Roads are impassable throughout the park. Parking areas are flooded. The campground electrical system and utilities were infiltrated by saltwater, requiring replacement. In order for us to make repairs, the park will be closed for the remainder of the 2017 calendar year. The Nature Center will reopen this Friday, September 15, and serve as an information hub for the park. If you have a reservation at Hunting Island between now and the end of 2017, you will be contacted and a full refund will be issued. Thank you for your patience and understanding during this time. 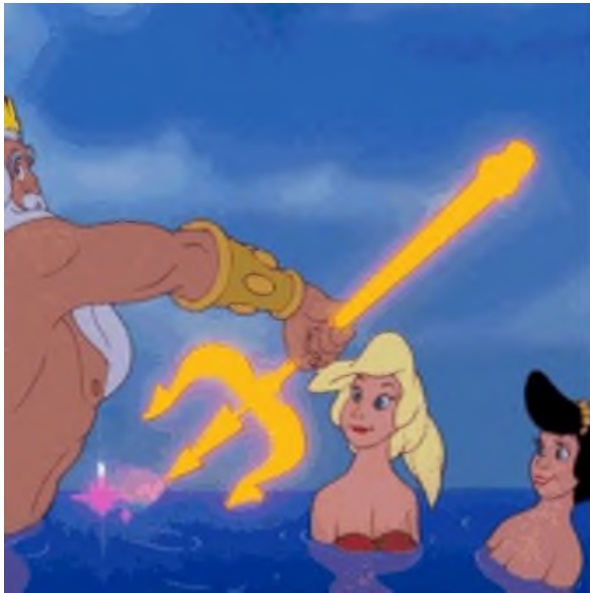
