- 1) The Governor's Order does not order RCRC Board members to appear at a hearing but instead provides them an opportunity to be heard & to exercise that opportunity they must request a hearing?
- 2) That a hearing is scheduled for tomorrow, Wed, Nov 30<sup>th</sup> at 10am? And that hearing has been scheduled because 1 or more of the RCRC Board Members made a request to be heard?
