Dear Rob,

Before the end of the session, I had asked Leigh about the Governor holding a bill signing for the Opt Out of Abortion Act and the Born-Alive Infant Protection Act.

The bill signing for the Born-Alive Act has been scheduled for Aug. 23 at 11:30 a.m. at the Carolina Pregnancy Care Center in Spartanburg, but signing of Opt Out apparently is not on the ceremony program.

We would respectfully ask Governor Haley also to add the Opt Out of Abortion Act (S 102) to the ceremony as a mostly timely piece of legislation given the U.S. Supreme Court decision upholding ObamaCare. We see Opt Out of Abortion as South Carolina's initial pushback to ObamaCare.
