Comments

This project consists of a reevaluation of the US 278 and SC 302 intersection improvement project, which was originally surveyed for cultural resources in Oct. 2013. Specific objectives included: 1) Reevaluation of potential impacts on cultural resources utilizing up-to-date project plans 2) Determining if any structures are present in the project area that currently meet the 50 year threshold for recordation but did not do so in 2013, or that may have been overlooked in 2013 3) Reevaluation of archaeological resources recorded but not assigned site numbers during the original survey and assignment of site numbers as appropriate. Results: 1) The project plans were found to be essentially the same as those in place in 2013; therefore no additional cultural resources survey is deemed necessary 2) One previously unrecorded structure dating to ca 1960 was identified and recorded as Site # 3516 but was assessed as not NRHP eligible 3) One structure recorded in 2013, site # 3493, was found to have been destroyed with a Dollar General store built on its former location 4) The two archaeological resources documented in 2013 were reevaluated and assigned site numbers (38AK1257 and 38AK1258), but were determined to be not NRHP eligible.

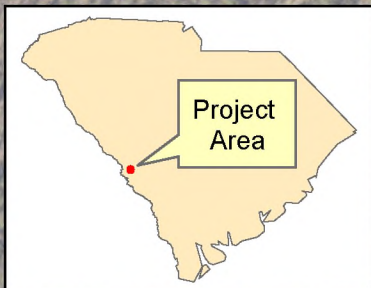
Effect Determination:

This screening form was developed to satisfy documentation requirements for Type I and Type II projects under a Programmatic Agreement between the Federal Highway Administration, the South Carolina State Historic Preservation Office, the US Army Corps of Engineers, and the South Carolina Department of Transportation. For Type I and Type II projects that have no effect on historic properties, the completion of this screening form with supporting documentation (e.g. ArchSite Map) provides evidence of FHWA and SCDOT's compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.
