Below is what was discussed:

- DOE is working with EPA on clean air waivers.
- DOE is working on easing standards to support industry transportation of fuel.
- The Colonial Bypass pipe is complete and in testing phase.
 - Colonial expects the pipe to be operational tomorrow.
 - Colonial representatives will reach out to each state with the expected timeframe of when the fuel will be getting back into the states (when the pipe becomes operational, it will have fuel running through it but it will take some time to reach each state).
- DOE suggests states:
 - Ensure coordination between state transportation, law enforcement, and energy offices; and
 - Work on RVP waivers.
