Katherine,

The information in the 2012 Legislative Manual she is referencing does not reflect the updated composition of the board after redistricting. Below is the updated composition of the board after redistricting:

State Athletic Commission, composition, terms of office

SECTION 13. Section 40-81-50(A) of the 1976 Code is amended to read:

"(A) There is created the State Athletic Commission consisting of **nine members** appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate to regulate boxing, kickboxing, wrestling, mixed martial arts, and other combative sports in this State. One member must be appointed from each congressional district of the State and two from the State at large. One of the at-large appointments must be a physician licensed and in good standing in the State. **The terms of the members are for four years and until their successors are appointed and qualified.** Vacancies must be filled by the Governor for the remainder of an unexpired term."

Other than congressional districts there are not specific occupational requirements to serve on the board, but by statute commissioners "may not have any financial interest, direct or indirect, in the promotion, management, or result of any boxing, kickboxing, mixed martial arts, or wrestling event or exhibition." Appointments also require Senate confirmation.

Members serve until their successors are appointed and qualify. The 4th Congressional District and At-large positions of Alan Wells and Pam Shealy both expired 6/30/2012, but their seats are not considered vacant and they are still considered members of the board.
