

The 2000 South Carolina 100®

This year marks the 15th year of the South Carolina 100®, a ranking of the state's largest privately held companies. Total revenues for the 1999 South Carolina 100® were \$11.6 billion. Milliken and Company of Spartanburg remains the top company in the ranking as the state's largest privately held business.

Other companies in the top 10 include: The InterTech Group Inc. and Affiliates in North Charleston (No. 2), Piggly Wiggly Carolina Co. Inc. of North Charleston (No. 3), Builder Marts of America Inc. of Greenville (No. 4), Southeastern Freight Lines Inc. of Columbia (No. 5), CMI Industries Inc. of Columbia (No. 6), JM Smith Corp. of Spartanburg (No. 7), TNS Mills Inc. of Greenville (No. 8), Thomas & Howard Co. Inc. of Columbia (No. 9), and Volume Services America of Spartanburg (No. 10).

There are 12 companies that have been part of the South Carolina 100® ranking for each of the past 15 years: Builder Marts of America Inc., Climatic Corp., Cox Industries Inc., Defender Services Inc., Kline Iron & Steel Co. Inc., Mayfair Mills Inc., McCrory Construction Co. Inc., Milliken and Company, Orders Distributing Co. Inc., Southeastern Freight Lines Inc., Thomas & Howard Co. Inc. and Young Pecan Co.

This year, there are four companies in the ranking for the first time. These are Edens & Avant of Columbia (No. 29), Advanced Automation Inc. of Greenville (No. 77), Ame Inc. of Fort Mill (No. 91) and FB Johnston Group of Chapin (No. 96).

Ten companies are returning to the ranking after an absence. These companies are Mashburn Construction Co. Inc. of Columbia (No. 78), Piedmont Mechanical Inc. of Spartanburg (No. 87), Cregger Co. Inc. of Columbia (No. 88), Central Textiles Inc. of Central (No. 89), Eagle Construction Co. Inc. of Newberry (No. 93), General

Wholesale Distributors Inc. of Greenville (No. 94), Boozer Lumber Co. Inc. of Columbia (No. 95), Park Place Corp. of Greenville (No. 97), GMK Associates Inc. of Columbia (No. 98), and Sands Investments Inc. of Myrtle Beach (No. 99).

The 10 companies with the largest rank increases are: Carolinas Recycling Group, L.L.C., climbed 38 spots to No. 52 from No. 90; H.G. Reynolds Co. Inc. up 32 places to 57 from 89; Utilities Construction Co. Inc. of South Carolina at No. 67, 29 places higher than last year's No. 96; Gregory Electric Co. Inc. in at No. 71, up from No. 98; Blackbaud Inc. at No. 40 from No. 63; Teleco Inc. at No. 75, up from No. 97; S.E.I. Inc.'s No. 53 was up 22 spots from No. 75; VyTech Industries Inc. at No. 62, 19 rankings above last year's No. 81; EIDeCo Inc. at No. 42 this year and No. 60 the past year; and Kline Iron & Steel Co. Inc. at No. 32, 17 spots higher than a year ago at No. 49.

Participation in the South Carolina 100® is voluntary, and companies are ranked based upon their net revenues for their most recently completed fiscal year. To qualify, companies must be privately held, headquartered in South Carolina, and cannot be a subsidiary or division of another company. Financial institutions, insurance companies, real estate and other brokerages, health care organizations and companies primarily engaged in retail are not eligible for the South Carolina 100® listing.
