Lieutenant Governor Kevin L. Bryant is from Anderson County, where he is a registered pharmacist and manages, with his brothers and father, Bryant Pharmacy & Supply, an independent “old corner drug store.” In 2004, Lieutenant Governor Bryant was elected to the South Carolina State Senate, where he served for 12 years. As a member of the Senate, he championed conservative legislation including the passage of a 24-hour waiting period and the requirement of ultrasound before an elective abortion. He’s been presented with the S.C. Citizens for Life Award and named “Friend of the Taxpayer” by the S.C. Association of Taxpayer.

Bryant was elected President Pro Tempore of the South Carolina State Senate before being sworn in as South Carolina’s 92nd Lieutenant Governor on January 25, 2017. In his role as Lieutenant Governor, Bryant serves as President of the South Carolina Senate and oversees the Lieutenant Governor’s Office on Aging. As Lieutenant Governor, he remains committed to his beliefs for limited government, lower taxes, and supporting traditional family values. He is married to his wife Ann and they have three children.
