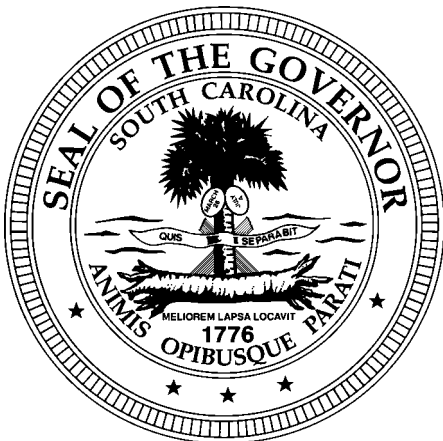
WHEREAS, women in construction exhibit skill and expertise in the workplace, performing their duties with true professionalism; and
