Last week, staff of AMERIGROUP Community Care had the opportunity to meet with Mr. Pete Bailey and Mr. David Patterson at the Office of Research & Statistics. We were privileged to a demonstration of the "Cubes", the detailed history of the data collection methodology and the level of detail contained on the Medicaid population of the State of South Carolina.

The collection of information in this data base is impressive to say the least. With the level of detail it contains we believe strongly that it will be a significant benefit to our health plan in managing beneficiaries.
