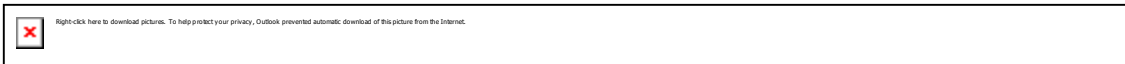

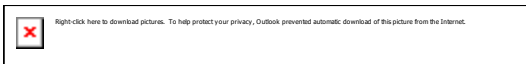

WHAT IS MIDLANDS GIVES?

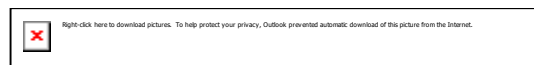
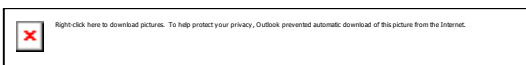

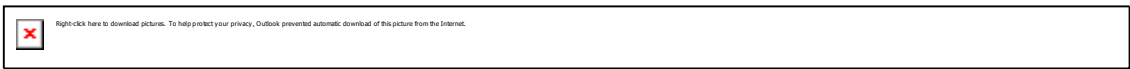
