The American Model or the International Model?

ED 527 focuses specifically on social infrastructure projects, defined as buildings and assets that accommodate social services. Examples include City Halls, Hospitals, Parking Garages, Laboratory Space, Municipal Office Space

and Public University buildings.

Currently in the P3 industry, there are two primary models for delivering a social infrastructure project to the public sector, The International Model (also known as DBOM) and the American Model (or Tax-Exempt Financing).

The International Model uses private sector Debt and Equity to finance the project and typically includes operations and maintenance for the project for a period that is usually equal to the life of the debt (30-40 years). This long-term operations and maintenance contract locks the government client into a contract for 30-40 years, in some cases longer, and is priced to account for profits flowing back to the developer.

The American Model takes advantage of tax-exempt debt available only governments and non-profits. This tax-exempt debt is cheaper, and allows for operations and maintenance to be managed through a competitive contracting process in 3-5 year terms renewable upon satisfaction of the government client. The American Model does not need to account for on-going developer profit, and provides for eventual transfer of ownership to the Public sector at no additional cost.
