SC's Youth Reaching for Success

Once again hundreds of young men and women from across the state flocked to Palmetto Boys State and Palmetto Girls State to learn the importance of politics and hard work. Nominated by their teachers, the students spent a week learning about the political process, teamwork, perseverance, and camaraderie. Girls State was held at Columbia College again this year, and Boys State found its home at the Citadel in Charleston.

In June, on a hot and hazy afternoon, I had the pleasure of meeting my counterparts from Boys and Girls State. Their pleasant smiles and great attitudes were just as warm and inviting. After talking to both students, I realized what strong and amazing personalities they both have.

The son of Thomas and Susan Moss, his strength and ability to succeed is astounding. When most people would have given up, Chris continued to strive for his goal of Commissioner of Agriculture at Boys State. Drawing from the teachings of his uncle, Harvey Jurecek, Chris decided to pursue the position that most interested him.

**Peanut Referendum
Results Announced**

The SC Peanut Board recently held a referendum among peanut growers on the continuance of the Peanut Marketing Order. Balloting was certified by the Agriculture Commission of SC on July 20, 2001.

Of the 23 ballots cast, 98% favored and 2% did not favor the continuance of the Marketing Order. Twenty-one growers having a total acreage of 3,210.2 (91% of the acreage volume) voted "YES." Only 2 growers having a total acreage of 55 acres (8% of the acreage volume) voted "NO."
