DIVISION OF GENERAL SERVICES - PURCHASE OF AIRPLANE BY AERONAUTICS

COMMISSION - The Division of General Services has reported that three bids were received in response to an invitation to provide the Aeronautics Commission with a King Air prop-jet airplane, the acquisition of which was authorized by Act 249 of 1977 (a Capital Improvement Bond Act).

The Division of General Services and the Aeronautics Commission have recommended that the contract for the referenced airplane be awarded to Stevens Beechcraft of Greer, the low bidder which met the bid specifications, at a purchase price of \$932,500.

The Division of General Services also reported that a lower bid to provide a King Air prop-jet airplane which did not meet bid specifications had been received.

After being assured by the Division of General Services that all established purchasing procedures had been followed in this instance, the Board members polled voted unanimously to award the contract for a King Air prop-jet airplane to Stevens Beechcraft, the low bidder which met the published bid specifications, at a purchase price of \$932,500.
