Dear Katherine,

To follow up on our conversation Monday, I've been working on a project of, I believe, huge implications and immense benefit to South Carolinians and beyond. I need the help of the Executive branch in order to change the dialogue and mindset of our state with regard to disaster response.

Attached is a letter and descriptive proposal I sent yesterday to you in the mail. This is the culmination of 18 months' work, solely of my own doing.

What I propose is a disaster response force (the working name of it is "STRONG ARM") to squarely address some of the most vexing recovery issues that exist after a catastrophe. It is built around the needs of (and funded by) the nuclear industry after such event occurs at a reactor, but the same techniques would be available to be deployed in myriad other, non-nuclear situations.

I have had high-level discussions with AREVA, a \$9B (yearly revenues) nuclear services firm over the past several months. They are highly interested executing such a service, which may involve licensing my methodologies.

I hope you can help me make such an organization that I propose a reality. It would make our state and country a safer place to live.
