3. FY 2011-2012 Education Foundation Supplement is not funded from the EFA appropriation nor does it require a Local share.							
4. FY 2011-2012 \$0 EFA State Support is not funded from the EFA appropriation and is the result of a school district's local EFA financial requirement at 100%.							
5. Definitions for the EOC add-on weights;							
A. Gifted & Talented - students who are classified as academically or artistically gifted and talented or who are enrolled in Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) courses in high school. It is not the intent to double count within this add-on weight.							
B. Academic Assistance - students who do not meet state standards on mathematics, English language arts or both to guarantee that the students receive additional educational instruction services. It is not the intent to double count students within this add-on weight.							
C. Adult Education - Adults aged 17 to 21 who are pursuing a diploma or GED through adult education or other means but are no longer part of the regular school setting.							
D. Limited English Proficiency - students with limited English proficiency who require intensive English language instruction programs and whose families require specialized parental involvement intervention.							
E. Pupils in Poverty - students eligible for the free or reduced price federal lunch program and/or eligible for Medicaid.							
6. Definition for additional add-on weight;							
A. Residential Treatment Facilities - students residing in a residential treatment facility.
