Gov. Nikki Haley and S.C. Department of Commerce Secretary Bobby Hitt left over the weekend on undisclosed economic development mission, the governor's office confirmed Monday. Though details of the trip are scarce, adding workforce to the state is at the forefront of the conversations.

Note: "Governor Haley's highest priority since taking office has been bringing jobs to every part of our state, and, to that end, the governor and Commerce officials are traveling on an economic development mission," said Rob Godfrey, Haley's deputy chief of staff.

S.C. Department of Commerce Secretary Bobby Hitt joined her on the trip that lasts through Wednesday, the governor's office said. A flight manifest with the S.C. Aeronautics Commission shows Hitt flying on a state plane to Washington Dulles International Airport on Sunday afternoon with three "confidential" passengers.

Note: "Due to the competitive nature of economic development, ongoing projects are confidential," Haley spokesman Rob Godfrey said. "But we will release details of the governor's trip, including the costs of travel, as soon as we are able to."
