[Roman Catholic] Cardinal Theodore McCarrick, the former [Roman Catholic] archbishop of Washington, was removed from ministry Wednesday, when [Roman Catholic false] church officials announced that he has been credibly accused of sexually abusing a teenager - and that he had faced three earlier allegations of sexual misconduct with adults.

Patrick Noaker, a Minneapolis lawyer representing McCarrick's alleged victim, said his client was a 16-year-old student at [Roman Catholic] Cathedral Preparatory School and Seminary in Queens in 1971 when he was picked to be an altar server for a special Christmas service at [Roman Catholic] St. Patrick's Cathedral.

McCarrick was known for traveling the world as a negotiator on human rights, including serving on an advisory committee for the U.S. secretary of state during the Clinton administration and serving on the U.S. Commission on International Religious Freedom from 1999 to 2001. He retired as [Roman Catholic] archbishop of Washington at the mandatory age of 75 but continued a high-profile travel schedule as a major global figure in the [Roman Catholic false] church.

In recent years, he participated in talks on religious freedom and nuclear weapons in China and Iran, part of a globe-trotting role in which he visited troubled locations at the request of the Vatican and occasionally the U.S. State Department.

A year into McCarrick's tenure as [Roman Catholic] archbishop of Washington, the Boston Globe exposed the massive scale of sexual abuse by [Roman] Catholic clergy, and McCarrick became a national leader of the [Roman Catholic false] church's response to the crisis. He helped write new standards at the Vatican and for all U.S. [Roman Catholic] bishops, becoming one of the first to strongly support a then-controversial one-strike-and-you're-out policy for [Roman Catholic] priests found to be abusers. The Post called him "an attractive public face" at a time the [Roman Catholic false] church sorely needed one.

McCarrick had embraced mandatory reporting policies even earlier, enacting rules that made Newark [Roman Catholic] churches report abuse to police in the early 1990s, and he pushed for similar policies on the national and global level.

As a young man studying to be a [Roman Catholic] priest in the 1980s, Robert Ciolek was flattered

when his brilliant, charismatic [Roman Catholic] bishop in Metuchen, N.J., Theodore E. McCarrick,

told him he was a shining star, cut out to study in Rome and rise high in the [Roman Catholic false] church.

[Roman Catholic] Bishop McCarrick began inviting him on overnight trips, sometimes alone and sometimes

with other young men training to be [Roman Catholic] priests. There, the [Roman Catholic] bishop would often assign Mr. Ciolek to share his room, which had only one bed. The two men would sometimes say night prayers together, before [Roman Catholic] Bishop McCarrick would make a request - "come over here and rub my shoulders a little"- that extended into unwanted touching in bed.

Mr. Ciolek, who was in his early 20s at the time, said he felt unable to say no, in part because he had been sexually abused by a teacher in his [Roman] Catholic high school, a trauma he had shared with the [Roman Catholic] bishop.

"I trusted him, I confided in him, I admired him," Mr. Ciolek said in an interview this month, the first time he has spoken publicly about the abuse, which lasted for several years while Mr. Ciolek was a [Roman Catholic] seminarian and later a [Roman Catholic] priest. "I couldn't imagine that he would have anything other than my best interests in mind."

[Roman Catholic] Bishop McCarrick went on to climb the ranks of the Roman Catholic hierarchy - from head of the small Diocese of Metuchen to [Roman Catholic] archbishop of Newark and then [Roman Catholic] archbishop of Washington, where he was made a [Roman Catholic] cardinal. He remained into his 80s one of the most recognized American [Roman Catholic] cardinals on the global stage, a Washington power broker who participated in funeral masses for political luminaries like [Roman Catholic] Edward M. Kennedy, the longtime Massachusetts senator, and [Roman Catholic] Beau Biden, the son of former Vice President [Roman Catholic] Joseph R. Biden Jr.

Suddenly, last month, [Roman Catholic] Cardinal McCarrick was removed from ministry, after the [Roman Catholic] Archdiocese of New York deemed credible an accusation that he had molested a 16-year-old altar boy nearly 50 years ago.

[Roman Catholic] Cardinal McCarrick, now 88, who declined to comment for this article, said in a statement last month that he had no recollection of the abuse. He is the highest-ranking [Roman] Catholic official in the United States to be removed for sexual abuse of a minor .

But while the [Roman Catholic false] church responded quickly to the allegation that [Roman Catholic] Cardinal McCarrick had abused a child, some [Roman Catholic false] church officials knew for decades that the [

Roman Catholic] cardinal

had been accused of sexually harassing and inappropriately touching adults, according to interviews and documents obtained by The New York Times.

Between 1994 and 2008, multiple reports about the [Roman Catholic] cardinal's transgressions with adult [Roman Catholic] seminary students were made to American [Roman Catholic] bishops, the [Roman Catholic] pope's representative in Washington and, finally, [Roman Catholic] Pope Benedict XVI. Two New Jersey [Roman Catholic] dioceses secretly paid settlements, in 2005 and 2007, to two men, one of whom was Mr. Ciolek, for allegations against the [Roman Catholic] archbishop. All the while, [Roman Catholic] Cardinal McCarrick played a prominent role publicizing the [Roman Catholic false] church's new zero-tolerance policy against abusing children.

In 2000, Pope John Paul II promoted [Roman Catholic] Archbishop McCarrick to lead the [Roman Catholic] Archdiocese of Washington D.C., one of the most prestigious posts in the [Roman] Catholic Church in America. He was elevated to [Roman Catholic] cardinal three months later.

In 2002, when the turmoil in the [Roman Catholic false] church over the child sex abuse scandal was at a peak, [Roman Catholic] Cardinal McCarrick was among the [Roman Catholic] cardinals summoned by the [Vatican's] pope to help manage the crisis.

[Roman Catholic] Cardinal McCarrick voted in the papal conclave in 2005 that elected [Rome's] Pope Benedict XVI, and participated in the [Roman Catholic] cardinals' meetings in 2013 that led to the election of [

Rome's] Pope Francis.

He retired as leader of the Washington [Roman Catholic] archdiocese in 2006 at 75, the standard retirement age for [Roman Catholic] bishops.

For many years, Mr. Ciolek, who became a lawyer after leaving the [Roman Catholic false] priesthood, told no one about his experiences. Then in 2004, after he began receiving counseling, he filed for a settlement from the church and received \$80,000 from the [Roman Catholic] Dioceses of Trenton, Metuchen and Newark.

Two years later, the [Roman Catholic false] church paid a settlement of \$100,000 to the other [Roman Catholic] priest alleging abuse. That [Roman Catholic] priest had been forced to resign in 2004 under the [Roman Catholic false] church's new zero-tolerance protocols against child abuse, based on his confession about touching two boys a decade earlier.

[Roman Catholic] Father [sic - Matthew 23:9, KJV] Ramsey said he continued to warn [Roman Catholic false] church leaders about [Roman Catholic] Cardinal McCarrick. In 2008, he said, he raised the issue with [Roman Catholic] Cardinal Edward Egan, the New York [Roman Catholic] archbishop, but [Roman Catholic] Cardinal Egan cut him off quickly. Father [sic - Matthew 23:9, KJV] Ramsey said he was disturbed in 2015 to see [Roman Catholic] Cardinal McCarrick serving at the funeral Mass for [Roman Catholic] Cardinal Egan, so he wrote to [Roman Catholic] Cardinal Seán O'Malley of Boston, who had been appointed by [Rome's JESUIT] Pope Francis to lead a commission on sexual abuse of children.

"I have blown the whistle for 30 years without getting anywhere," Father [sic - Matthew 23:9, KJV] Ramsey said recently.

[Roman Catholic] Cardinal O'Malley, through a spokesman, declined to comment.

Richard Sipe, a former [Roman Catholic] priest who is an authority on clergy sex abuse, said that [Roman Catholic] seminarians began to confide in him about the beach house sleepovers while he was a professor at St. Mary's Seminary and University in Baltimore in the 1980s. He said he wrote a letter to [Rome's] Pope Benedict in 2008, telling him the illicit trips to the shore home "had been widely known for several decades."

It was the beginning of a **sexually abusive relationship that would last nearly 20 years**, James said in the interview, the first time he has spoken publicly about the trauma. He asked that his last name be withheld to protect a sibling.

As the decades passed, Father [sic - **Matthew 23:9, KJV**] McCarrick became [**Roman Catholic**] Cardinal McCarrick, **one of the most prominent public faces of the [Roman] Catholic Church in America.** He was **suddenly removed from ministry last month** over a substantiated allegation that he sexually assaulted a 16-year-old altar boy in 1971.

The news changed James's life. "I got down on my knees and I thanked God that I am not alone and it is going to be O.K.," James said, through sobs, recalling the moment. "And I can tell somebody and someone is going to believe me."

Interviews and documents obtained by The New York Times after [**Roman Catholic**] Cardinal McCarrick's removal showed that some in the [**Roman Catholic false**] church hierarchy had known for decades about allegations that he was sexually harassing

and touching adult [Roman Catholic] seminarians. On Monday, The Times reported that a former priest, Robert Ciolek, had received an \$80,000 settlement in 2005, in part over allegations that [Roman Catholic] Cardinal McCarrick, as a New Jersey [Roman Catholic] bishop in the 1980s, had sexually harassed and inappropriately touched him. Another former [Roman Catholic] seminarian received a \$100,000 settlement for similar allegations in 2007.

But James' allegations - that he was repeatedly sexually abused as a minor - are the most explosive yet to be leveled against the [Roman Catholic] cardinal, who is now 88 and living in seclusion in the Washington, D.C., area. On Monday, James filed a police report detailing his accusations against the [Roman Catholic] cardinal with the Loudoun County Sheriff's Office in Virginia, where he lives .

NEW YORK, June 20, 2018 ([LifeSiteNews](#)) – A high-profile liberal U.S. [Roman Catholic] cardinal has been removed from public ministry for credible and substantiated allegations of abuse of a minor.

[Roman Catholic] Cardinal Theodore McCarrick, a former [Roman Catholic] priest of the [Roman Catholic] Archdiocese of New York and [Roman Catholic] cardinal emeritus of Washington D.C., "is no longer to exercise publicly his [Roman Catholic false] priestly ministry," says a news release from New York [Roman Catholic] Cardinal Timothy Dolan.

"The review board found the allegations credible and substantiated," [Dolan's statement](#) said.

"The Vatican Secretary of State, [Roman Catholic] Cardinal Pietro Parolin, at the direction of [Rome's JESUIT] Pope Francis, has instructed [Roman Catholic] Cardinal McCarrick that he is no longer to exercise publicly his [Roman Catholic false] priestly ministry," the [Roman Catholic] cardinal said.

McCarrick is alleged to have sexually abused a minor five decades ago when he was a [Roman Catholic] priest in the [Roman Catholic] Archdiocese of New York, a statement from Metuchen, NJ, [Roman Catholic] Bishop James Checchio said.

Editor's note: Catholic journalist and commentator Matt Abbott has written about the [Roman] Catholic Church's sex abuse crisis since its earlier days, including in particular [Cardinal Theodore McCarrick, who was removed from public ministry in June](#) resulting from credible and substantiated allegations of abuse of a minor. [McCarrick's abuse](#) of [Roman Catholic] seminarians

and young [Roman Catholic false] priests under his purview while a [Roman Catholic false] bishop was a widely known secret among some journalists and many in the [Roman Catholic false] Church for years and was finally brought to light with his recent removal.

Abbott was among those reporting on the abuse – when the story was largely ignored by journalists, quashed by some editors, and apparently enabled by [Roman Catholic false] Church leadership. Many who knew about the abuse were afraid to go on record for fear of repercussions, frustrating the work of journalists who were investigating and trying to report on the story.

One man, a former [Roman Catholic] priest, reached out to Abbott at the time and confirmed the stories about McCarrick on the record.

Some years later, the man requested that Abbott remove his name from Abbott's column due to its negative effect on his livelihood.

Abbott complied, taking down that and another column he'd written on other McCarrick abuse with concern for the greater good. [???]

The former [Roman Catholic] priest has reached out to Abbott in the wake of McCarrick's recent widespread exposure, willing to go back on the record.
