Dear Governor Haley,

On the morn of this Veteran's Day 2015, I sit and ponder, giving thanks and appreciation to all the men and women that so unselfishly sacrifice so much to preserve our freedom. I know you also feel a deep appreciation for our veterans and active military personnel.

Almost six years ago, a small group of citizens living here in Hampton Hall in Bluffton, SC, sat around a table after a round of golf, and discussed that something should and could be done to help our wounded soldiers here in the Lowcountry. From this casual discussion, the Lowcountry Foundation for Wounded Military Heroes emerged, and in 5 short years, has raised over \$500,000 to directly benefit those wounded heroes here in the Lowcountry. Last year alone, over \$185,000 was raised in a two day event. It is important to note that this organization is run 100% by volunteers, and all the money goes to the stated mission of helping wounded heroes. In fact, there are over 125 volunteers that are guided by a small group of board members and committee leaders. Their only reward is knowing that their hard work and dedication results in helping these amazing soldiers that are in need.

Mayor Lisa Sulka has always played a role in the event, as minimally as reading a proclamation at the opening ceremonies, to last year, jumping out of an airplane with a paratrooper team to kick off the event, and sitting in a dunk tank at our Inaugural Festival for Heroes. Last year, albeit relatively late, I invited you to attend via your website. I did receive a phone call from one of your staff members that explained you had a prior commitment. I am writing to you personally this year, in the hope that you may be able to schedule to attend one of our events.

This year, we will be holding our Festival for Heroes on April 3<sup>rd</sup> on the grounds of Hampton Hall in Bluffton. We will have live music, food vendors, Fire and Police Department exhibits and demonstrations, games and activities for all, silent auctions, and more. We are also planning on the addition of a 5K and 10K run, followed by a first annual Fishing for Heroes fishing tournament.

Our main event, the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Wounded Heroes Golf Classic, will be held here at Hampton Hall on Monday, May 16<sup>th</sup>. At this tournament, our opening ceremonies include parachute jumps, presentation of the colors by the Bluffton Police, bagpiper procession, and singing of the National Anthem by a local theater ensemble. We have 18 to 24 wounded heroes in attendance that receive free golf lessons and participate in the

tournament, playing along side the other participants. That evening, at the awards presentation and dinner, we have keynote speakers that address the attendees, talking about the tremendous needs and how much need and appreciation there is for fundraising efforts like ours. There usually isn't a dry eye in the crowd. A silent auction and live auction concludes the festivities.

On May 15<sup>th</sup>, the evening before the Golf Classic, we will conduct a Community and Volunteer Appreciation event. A light dinner, auction, live music, and guest speakers gives homage to the community and all of our volunteers.

As you can see, the LFWMH has grown and continues to do so. We can never do enough to thank the wounded soldiers, but we can at least make an effort to assure they will never be forgotten.

I personally invite you to share in our 2016 fundraising efforts and celebration for our wounded heroes. As Governor, your time is valuable, and we all appreciate that. With three different dates and events, it is hoped that you may possibly attend this year. I can certainly offer our residence here at Hampton Hall for you to stay, arrange for local transportation, or anything that may facilitate your presence. Should you have any questions at all, please feel free in contacting me at your convenience.








## **Lowcountry Foundation For Wounded Military Heroes Raises a Record \$185,000**

BLUFFTON, SC- On Monday, June 29, the Lowcountry Foundation for Wounded Military Heroes presented the *Birdies for the Brave*, a PGA TOUR Charities affiliate, with a donation of \$185,000. In the past five years the Foundation has raised a total of \$500,000 that directly benefits veterans in this area who have been wounded in Iraq and Afghanistan. The following homefront charities will receive donations this year: (1) K9's for Warriors, (2) Operation Homefront, (3) Military Warriors Support Foundation, (4) Special Operations Warrior Foundation, (5) Green Beret Foundation and (6) Navy SEAL Foundation.

The fifth annual Wounded Heroes Golf Classic was hosted again at Hampton Hall on May 18, which was preceded for the first time by a Festival For Heroes community event on May 17. Activities, which included food vendors, games, musical artists, and live/silent auctions, were planned to both thank volunteers for their efforts, and also raise additional donations. The spectacular Opening Ceremonies once again welcomed over 160 golfers, who were joined by 20 special guests who are wounded veterans from area Army, Navy, and Marine Corps units. Bluffton Mayor Lisa Sulka kicked off the ceremony by reading a Proclamation issued by the Bluffton Town Council, after she completed a tandem parachute jump onto the 9<sup>th</sup> green with the Special Forces Association Parachute Team, who once again delivered the colors. Sgt Major Dwayne Farr (USMC, ret) played "America the Beautiful" on the bagpipes accompanied by a student drill team representing the MCJROTC program from Whale Branch Early College High School. The Bluffton Police Honor Guard posted the colors as cast members from the Savannah Theatre group sang the National Anthem. Following the golf event, a cocktail reception, dinner, and silent and live auctions were hosted at the Hampton Hall Community Clubhouse. The evening concluded with awards and a keynote address by Lt. Col. Gade, a wounded hero who is now on the staff at West Point Military Academy.
