Over the past two years Moncks Corner Pediatrics, LLC has suffered financially as the result of a former employee who was entrusted with the financial responsibilities within the practice, including filing insurance claims. Recently this employee was released and charged with embezzlement, and is now facing additional charges for intentional negligence.

On November 15, 2010 I was hired by Dr. West as the practice administrator. During this time I have discovered that many insurance claims over the past couple of years were never filed. It has also been discovered that many of the remittances received were never posted to the patient's account which made the aging A/R report appear grim. Among the few items mention there are many more billing discrepancies. I hope you can sympathize with practice on the financial hardship we are facing. The act of negligence from the prior employee has had a tremendous affect on the financial position of the practice.

In an effort to financially restore MCPeds, I am requesting your consideration to waive all claims denied for timely filing from January 1, 2010 to present. MCPeds has been placed in a difficult position at no fault of their own. 

Dear Ms. Fain:

The South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (SCDHHS) is in receipt of your letter to the Director of South Carolina Medicaid concerning claims denied for timely filing. Your letter states that the issue causing the timely filing was due to an employee's embezzlement and neglect. On Wednesday March 23, 2011, you spoke with Ms. Maureen Ryan with the Division of Pharmacy, DME, and Physician Services and discussed that the claims in question were for dates of service from July 23, 2009 to January 28, 2010.

The Physician Laboratory and Other Medical Professionals manual states in Section I, page 25: "SCDHHS requires that only 'clean' claims and related ECFs received and entered into the claims processing system within one year from the date of service (or date of discharge for hospital claims) be considered for payment. A 'clean' claim is error-free and can be processed without obtaining additional information from the provider or from another third party. This time limit will not be extended on the basis of third-party liability requirements. However, the one-year time limit does not apply to Medicare cost sharing claims or to claims involving retroactive eligibility." We have reviewed your request and while the circumstances are unfortunate, we are unable to extend the agencies timely filing limitations to your practice.
